## 2016 APPLICATION

### GENERAL OVERVIEW

The Governing Board of the Downriver Council for the Arts has established this scholarship program to provide assistance and encouragement to high school graduates who are pursuing academic education in any arts genre (visual, music, dance, theatre, literature, film, graphic, etc.). The scholarship is open to 2016 graduating seniors who reside within the 21 DCA communities. Public, private and home-schooled students are eligible. *DCA Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, national origin or financial need.*

**SUBMISSION DEADLINE: TUESDAY, APRIL 19, 2016**

### APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

All applicants **MUST** be:

1. A current graduating high school senior residing in one of the 21 DCA cities.
2. Pursuing an arts-related field (visual, music, dance, theatre, literature, film, graphic, etc.) through a recognized post-secondary educational institution.
3. Available for an interview by the DCA Scholarship Selection Committee, if necessary.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants **MUST** submit:

1. A fully completed DCA Scholarship Application.
2. A personal statement of goals that:
  - a. is written by the applicant.
  - b. is no longer than one typed page.
  - c. address the applicant's interest in the arts, reasons for applying and educational/career goals.
3. A digital copy (up to 3 in one discipline) of examples of their art (images for visual, CD for musical, video for theatre, DVD for film, maximum 1,000-word typed writing sample for literature).
4. A digital image of applicant (for promotional purposes).
5. Two sealed letters of recommendation (1 from a current teacher/instructor, 1 personal reference).
6. Transcript (unofficial copy acceptable) showing G.P.A.
7. All required information by the deadline date.

3. No late or incomplete entries will be accepted.
4. No faxed or e-mailed applications or letters of recommendation will be accepted.
5. All applications will be reviewed by the DCA Scholarship Selection Committee.
6. Depending on the number of applicants, the DCA Scholarship Selection Committee may also require interviews of the finalists.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be scored competitively and awarded based on the following point system:

1. Accuracy and presentation of application (15 pts.)
2. Personal statement (up to 15 pts)
3. Letters of recommendations (up to 20 pts.)
4. Applicant's artwork or literature (up to 30 pts.)
5. Interview – if needed (up to 20 pts)
