Unleash Your Artistic Talents!

Acrylic Painting – Beginners to Advanced (Ages 11-15) - Tanner

In this class, students will learn the basic techniques and application of water based acrylic painting. While learning established artistic styles each student will be able to explore their own style by painting still life, landscapes and seascapes.

Advanced Acrylics (Ages 11-15) – Tanner (New!)

This class will pick up and merge with the previous class the week before. Further techniques and advanced elements and style of painting will be taught: how to enhance skies, clouds and weather into artwork. Will work on such elements as water, lakes, streams and especially the ocean and waves and how to create depth and movement. Students will start to see their own “style” develop as they paint their “own” masterpiece.

Building with Clay (Ages 6-10) - Grandy

Students have fun using air set clay to create art projects such as: sculptures of animals, plaques, jewelry, masks and more. The creations will be painted and make great keepsakes and gifts for friends.

Creative Drawing for Teens (Ages 11-15) – Mastal (New!)

Students will learn the artistic drawing techniques to create unique designs in Steampunk, Zen Tangle, Mandala and more.

Creative Hand Sewing (Ages 6-10) – Daley (New!)

At the beginning of each week, students learn how to use a needle and thread. Week one students will be making sachets, scrappy heart pins, cookie coin savers, stuffed letters and more. Week two students will be creating a stuffed animal of their own, a stuffed monster, as well as a sleepy bear in a sleeping bag. Week three Students will sew a simple shoulder bag, a doorknob sign, and wallet and more. Have fun working with fabric, thread, buttons and trims while learning a lifelong skill.

DIY Canvas (Ages 11-15) – Durant (New!)

Learn new and exciting ways to use a canvas! Paint, stencil, cut, light and font techniques are taught using canvas.

Don't Yuck My Yum (Ages 6-10 & 11-15) – Durant (New!)

This class is a blast! Students will be using food as an art form. Sculpting, painting and decorating techniques will be taught.

Drawing (Ages 11-15) – Borza

Students will learn drawing techniques using various pencils, blenders and erasers to gain a knowledge in realistic drawing.

Drawing & Painting (Ages 6-10) - Hinson

Learn to draw in pencil, pen, ink and other mediums. Use your drawing skills to paint in acrylic, pastels and watercolor.

Earth to Art (Ages 6-10) – Hinson (New!)

Have fun learning about art from cultures around the world. A lot of different materials and techniques will be used to create fun projects.

Eco-Chic Jewelry (Ages 6-10) – Sara Wilkins (New!)

In this fun camp, students will learn about the basic jewelry making techniques as they design and create jewelry from natural and up-cycled materials. Campers will create bracelets, necklaces and earrings using materials such as paper, plastic, chip bags, soda tabs and more. **THERE IS A \$5 FEE FOR THIS CAMP.**

Enchanted Fairy Renaissance (Ages 6-10) – Durant (New!)

Young artists will create fairy doors, fairy or dragon wings, fairy jars or lightening bug jars, a wand or sword and head bands.

Improv (Ages 11-15) – St. Martin (New!)

Want to learn how to think on your feet? Perform an unscripted play in seconds? Put your improvisational skills to the test and learn the basics on how to be an improv actor in a week and perform in a improv showcase on Friday? You will learn comic timing, scene building, group mind, and many other improv games and techniques.

Little Miss Runway (Ages 6-10) - Zemke

A very popular class at the DCA! We will create fashionable items to wear. Hand sewing and crafting are involved. Projects include: Yoyo headbands, fun button sewing, hand warmers, fashion accessories and tutus. During the class, we will be practicing how to walk a runway. On the last day, parents are invited for a runway performance wearing camp creations.

Mixed Media Nautical (Ages 11-15) – Zemke (New!)

We will explore the oceans deep through art. Various art techniques will be used to create ocean adventures, including a treasure map. We will be using pastel chalks, sandpaper, sand, natural sponges, shells, paint, glue, tissue paper and other mixed media items. Subjects include water life, mermaids and sea creatures, nautical items, lifesavers, sailboats, light houses to capture the beauty of water itself.

Painting with the Masters (Ages 6-10) – Hinson

Learn how different artists created their artwork such as Van Gogh, Monet and many others. Paint with various types of paints.

Puppets (Ages 6-10) – Zemke

Everyone loves puppets! We will be making a variety of styles from finger to sock puppets to keep campers busy. A puppet theatre will be created using a variety of items from foam shapes, bottle lids, felt, etc. Campers creativity is their only limit. Loads of fun!

Sculpture - It's All in the Round! (Ages 6-10) – Hinson (New!)

Build, carve and use lots of messy materials. Students will learn how to create abstract sculpture and realistic! Make a robot sculpture, birds and much more.

Star Wars (Ages 6-10 & 11-15) – Durant (New!)

May the force be with you! The force will guide young Jedi's to create Star Wars themed paintings and crafts. Teens will use paint and mixed media to create their DIY projects.

Steampunk & Stuff (Ages 11-15) – Zemke

Different from our Steampunk class of prior years, we will make a fun mini top hat and various other items. Another fun element is added for our week long agenda – stuffing! A few of the planned activities are fun stuffed creature creations and cultural items like Day of the Dead inspired skull pillows. This is a busy class. Items used will be junk jewelry, buttons, watch parts, gears, socks, fabric, screws and other miscellaneous gadgets. Markers, paint and glue will be used. Basic hand sewing may be used.

Sticks & Stones (Ages 6-10) – Zemke (New!)

Explore nature! In this class, we will make art and craft projects that are inspired by the outdoors. We will use rocks, sticks and leaves in our creations. **CANCELLED**

Street Smart Art (Ages 11-15) – Durant

Students will learn graffiti techniques using stencils, lettering and mural design, yarn bombs and found object sculpture.

Teen Runway (Ages 11-15) – Zemke

This camp will give inspiring fashion designers and sewers a chance to create their own items. Focus is on developing basic machine and hand sewing techniques. **Campers need to supply their own sewing machine (no kiddy machines).** Students learn how to operate their machine themselves and will be working on a basic elastic skirt, scarves, handbags and fashion accessories. They will practice how to walk a runway and parents will be invited for a performance the last day of camp showcasing their creations. **CANCELLED**

Theatre Camp (Ages 6-10 & 11-15) – Walter

Our student actors will practice the basics of theatre including storytelling, character development, improvisation, stage movement and more. The students will work together to create an original story and perform it for their family and friends.

Vocal Camp (Ages 6-10 & 11-15) – Walter

Students will be taught vocal techniques, such as breathing, vocal fundamentals and some music theory. It will culminate in a short live performance for family and friends.

Watercolor (Ages 11-15) – Hinson

Students will learn basic and advanced techniques in watercolor. A variety of subjects will be taught, such as florals, abstract, etc.
